Here are some helpful hints and tips to make the move a little easier.

Immigration, travel and documentation
Research and apply for any required visas
☐ Book your flights
☐ Book your shipping company for any belongings you want to bring to Australia
☐ Organise travel, health and shipping insurance for your trip and belongings
Find out what you can import and any duties you will need to pay
☐ Make sure your passport is valid and matches your visa requirements
☐ Find your Birth certificate
☐ Check your <u>Driver's license</u> will not expire in the first three months of your Australian arrival
Home and finance
\square Ask your bank about the best way to manage your account while you are in Australia.
☐ Consider opening an <u>Australian bank account</u>
☐ Create a list of services you will need to cancel when you move, such as:
☐ Electricity
☐ Water bill
☐ Gas
☐ Internet (Wi-Fi)
☐ Phone bill
☐ Water and land council rates
Home and contents insurance





☐ Make a list of people and companies you will need to notify of your change of address
Accommodation
Research locations factoring in lifestyle, transport, schools and budget
Research accommodation options in your desired location/s
Employment
☐ Check your visa for any work related restrictions
☐ Check if your desired Australian job requires a licence, permit or qualification
☐ Update your resume/curriculum vitae
☐ Organise professional references and academic transcripts to support your applications
☐ Start looking for potential job opportunities
