



## Western Australia Designated Area Migration Agreement – Endorsement application guide

The Western Australia Designated Area Migration Agreement (DAMA) endorsement application form requires information relating to the following:



Initial checklist



Genuine workforce need and positions



Business information



Summary



Contact



Conditions

Migration Services have put together the information below to guide employers through the endorsement application form, which can be saved and resumed at any point.



### Initial checklist

This section requires:

- your [Skilled Migrant Employment Register](#) registration details
- the number of positions you are requesting for endorsement
- confirmation that you understand and can meet the eligibility requirements.



### Business information

This section requires details of the nominating business such as:

- legal details (such as trading name and Australian Business Number (ABN))
- WA business address
- location of head office.

### Contact

This section requires contact details for people who you authorise to submit and receive information relating to your endorsement application.



## Genuine workforce need and positions

This section requires details of the positions you are seeking endorsement for, such as:

- details of the nominated position/s
- terms of employment
- labour market testing.

**In this section, you will be able to add multiple positions, including different visas, locations and concessions.**
